Philosophy, Goals, Objectives and Comprehensive Plans

School Plans/Site Councils

The school site council described below is a prerequisite to participation in the state's School-Based Coordinated Program, School Improvement Program, Education Improvement Incentive Program or School-Based Pupil Motivation and Maintenance Program.

When required for participation in state programs, school site councils shall be composed of the following:

- the principal
- teachers selected by the school's teachers
- other school personnel chosen by the school's other personnel
- parents/guardians of students attending the school, chosen by other such parents/guardians *or* community members chosen as representatives by such parents/guardians
- secondary students attending the school, chosen by other such students

Half of the school site council membership shall consist of school staff, the majority of whom shall be classroom teachers. The remaining half shall be equal numbers of parents/guardians (or parents/guardians representatives) and students.

A district employee may serve as a parent/guardian representative on the site council of the school his/her child attends, provided the employee does not work at that school.

School site councils may function on behalf of other committees in accordance with law.

A current roster of school site members, with roles identified, shall be included with all school plans.
