Philosophy, Goals, Objectives and Comprehensive Plans

School Plans/Site Councils

The Governing Board encourages district employees, students, parents/guardians and other members of the school community to develop school plans designed to meet the specific needs at individual school sites.

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that schools desiring to participate in state-funded school-based programs establish and maintain a school site council. The school site council shall develop a three-year school improvement plan in accordance with requirements of the Education Code and policy of the Board. Upon Board approval of the plan, the school site council shall assume responsibility for the ongoing review of its implementation and the annual evaluation of the program's effectiveness and for other duties as prescribed by law. The council shall annually review the plan, establish the plan budget, and update the plan to reflect changing improvement needs and priorities.

The Board may approve or disapprove school plans as necessary in order to fulfill the district's mission, accomplish the Board's adopted goals and/or comply with legal requirements.
