Comprehensive Local Plan for Special Education

The Governing Board approves the declaration by the California State Legislature that "all individuals with exceptional needs have a right to participate in free appropriate public education and that special education instruction and services for these persons are needed in order to ensure them of the right to an appropriate educational opportunity to meet their unique needs."
(Education Code 56000)

To meet the needs of children with exceptional needs as completely as possible, the district is a fully participating member of the West Orange County Consortium for Special Education (WOCCE) Local Planning Area. The other member districts of WOCCE include: Fountain Valley School District, Huntington Beach City School District, Ocean View School District, and Westminster School District.

The Superintendent is instructed to extend the full cooperation of the district to the WOCCE. The regulations and procedures of the special education local planning area shall be applied as regulations and procedures of this district.

A copy of the local plan for special education of the WOCCE, together with appropriate regulations and procedures, shall be available for inspection at the office of the Superintendent and at such other locations as the Superintendent directs.
