Local Agencies

Law Enforcement Agencies

The principal, or his/her designee, shall notify appropriate law enforcement authorities of any student acts, which may be violative of Penal Code 245.

Fire Department

Members of the local fire departments play a vital role in the school safety program. It shall be the responsibility of each building principal to:

1. Establish and maintain relationships with the local department.
2. Work with his/her faculty in determining the nature and timing of the department's participation in the school program.
3. Coordinate and supervise the planned activities.

Health Department

1. Purpose and Scope

To delineate responsibilities in working and cooperating with the Health Department.

2. Regulations

- A. It shall be the responsibility of the principal to assist in meeting the provisions of the Health Department covering communicable and contagious diseases by promptly reporting to the school nurse and Superintendent the presence of such disease. He/she shall not reenter any such pupil without securing a written permit from the nurse who is his/her authorized representative. All permits shall be filed as a matter of record.

Health Department (continued)

- B. Parents who cannot afford medical or dental care for their children should be referred to the public health nurse for guidance in obtaining care either through the Department of public health or other resources. Such referral is especially important in the case of required vaccinations and immunizations.
