School-connected Organizations (includes Parent/Booster clubs)

The Governing Board recognizes that parents may wish to organize booster clubs for the purpose of supporting special programs. These programs may include athletic teams, debate teams, school musical groups, academic groups, performing groups, Graduation Night Committees and other activities that provide a source of positive involvement for students.

While the Board is supportive of such activities, and welcomes the interest and participation of parents in various aspects of student life, it recognizes that such booster clubs are not functions of the school or the District, and that they act and operate independently of the school and District. Parent/guardian clubs shall be especially careful not to seek advantages for the activities they support if those advantages might be detrimental to the entire school program. In order to protect the District and students, the Superintendent or designee shall establish appropriate controls for the relationship between such organizations and the District.
