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Community Relations

Local Agencies

It is the policy of the Governing Board to maintain effective working relationships with all local governmental agencies (i.e., law enforcement, fire department), particularly those, which affect the operations of the schools.

The Superintendent is directed to work closely and cooperatively with such agencies, and to bring all areas of conflict to the Board whenever it appears that they cannot be promptly and appropriately resolved.

Health Department

The Governing Board advocates close working relationships with the Health Department in all school matters. The school staff shall safeguard the health of the student in school by supplementing and reinforcing the efforts of the home and by providing conditions and educational opportunities conducive to good health.
