Business and Noninstructional Operations

Free and Reduced Lunch Program

The District's plan for students receiving free or reduced price meals shall set forth the following conditions:

1. The names of the students shall not be published, posted or announced in any manner, or used for any other purpose other than the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs, LCFF allocation, assessment, and accountability requirements, and to determine student eligibility for test fee waivers, college application fee waivers, and scholarships, among other educational benefits to the student.
2. There shall be no overt identification of any of the students by the use of special tokens or tickets or by any other means.
3. The students shall not be required to work for their meals or milk.
4. The students shall not be required to use a separate dining area, go through a separate entrance, or consume their meals or milk at a different time.
5. When more than one lunch, breakfast or type of milk is offered, the students shall have the same choice of meals or milk as is available to those students who pay the full price.

Applications and Records

An application form for free or reduced price meals shall be distributed to all parents/guardians at the beginning of each school year, together with information about eligibility standards, application procedures, appeal procedures, and the educational benefits of eligibility. This form and information shall also be provided whenever a new student is enrolled. (Education Code 49520, 48980)

1. Applications for free or reduced price meals may be submitted at any time during a school day.
2. Children participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs will not be overtly identified by the use of special tokens, tickets, special serving lines, separate entrances, separate dining areas or by any other means.

All applications and records related to eligibility for the free or reduced price meal program shall be confidential. They shall be open to examination for purposes of this program or for any investigation, prosecution, or criminal or civil proceeding conducted in connection with the administration of any free and reduced price meal program. (Education Code 49558)

Use of Eligibility Information

The Board authorizes the following district employees to designate school officials with a legitimate educational interest, and on a “need to know” basis to use individual records pertaining to student participation in the free or reduced price meal program solely for the purpose of disaggregation of academic achievement data:

Assistant Superintendent, Education Services
Executive Director of Curriculum, Instruction, and Categorical Programs
Director of Student Services

In using these records for that purpose, the following conditions shall be satisfied: (Education Code 49558)

1. No individual indicators of participation in the free or reduced price meal program shall be maintained in the permanent records of any students if not otherwise allowed by law.
2. Information regarding individual student participation in the free or reduced price meal program shall not be publicly released.
3. All other confidentiality provisions required by law shall be met.
4. The designated employees have a legitimate educational interest.
5. The designated employees possess a “need to know” basis for accessing this information.
6. The information collected regarding individual students certified to participate in the free and reduced price meals program is destroyed when no longer needed for its intended purpose.
