## Business and Non-Instructional Operations

### Competitive Food Sales on Campus by Student Organizations and Adult Organizations

For purposes of complying with Board Policy 3554, an organization is an approved group or club within the school. Only one student club or organization may conduct food and beverage sales each day. The Associated Student Body and a club, such as the Spanish Club, are two separate organizations. If the A.S.B. student store is selling food and beverage, there may be no other food and beverage sales by other organizations on campus during the regular school day.

The operation of a vending machine by an approved student organization meets the limit of one organization per day. The operation of both the A.S.B. student store and an organization's vending machine on the same day is prohibited.

In order to avoid disruption of instruction, authorized sales of food and beverages must be conducted outside the classroom.

An approved adult organization may sell food/beverage after the regular school day. California Code of Regulations (Section 15501) requirements still apply.

Outside food contractors are not permitted to sell on campus during the school day. Examples of an outside food contractor would be:

- 1) "In-N-Out Burger" coming onto a campus and selling food and beverages directly to students and staff during the school day;
- 2) a vending machine vendor who sells food and beverages during the school day;
- 3) a catering truck which comes on campus to sell food and beverages during the day.

Food and beverages sold in competition with the food and nutrition program shall be sold at or above the Board approved prices.

Groups or organizations that fail to heed BP 3554 after repeated administrative warnings will not be permitted to hold food or beverage sales until such a time as determined by the Governing Board or the designee.
