Student Rank Within Class

Class ranking specifies the relative academic standing of each student within a graduating class of any given year as measured by his/her accumulated grade point average (GPA) for specified courses.

GPA represents the total number of grade points earned divided by the total number of units of classwork attempted. Total grade points are the product of each individual grade and the units of credit for the respective course. A grade of A = 4 points, B = 3 points, C = 2 points, D = 1 point, F = 0 points; certain courses designated as Honors, International Baccalaureate or Advanced Placement will be awarded a bonus factor based on a passing grade.

Coursework Stipulations

Physical education shall be included in the accumulated GPA for class rank calculation.

All other coursework attempted during the 9th through 12th grades shall be included.

Where two or more students are tied for the next rank position because of identical GPAs, they will ~~should~~ be assigned the same rank number and subsequent ranks will be skipped by the number of tied rank positions. Unless a tie exists for the last class rank assigned, it shall be numerically equal to the total number of students in the class.

In the case of remediated courses, the higher grade will be used to calculate GPA.
