School Bus Advisors

1. Purpose and Scope

To establish rules for adult advisors and chaperones riding district school buses for the purpose of defining their responsibilities while passengers.

2. Regulations

The following regulations will apply for adults riding on district school buses:

- A. All adults riding on district school buses are considered chaperones and should at all times assist the driver in areas of safety and discipline in compliance with State and Federal laws governing student transportation.
- B. Advisors on school buses will either be a member of the staff, a volunteer in public education or an adult authorized by the local campus.
- C. Dependent children or students that do not attend Huntington Beach Union High School District aren't permitted to ride district buses without prior authorization of the local principal or his/her designee. Such authorization will only be granted in bonafide emergencies such as the following:
 - (1) Inability to obtain a babysitter due to last-minute problems or excessive costs.
 - (a) Dependent children must be closely supervised at all times. They must remain seated and abide by established rules.
 - (b) The principal will determine whether the situation constitutes an emergency. Discretion will be used to determine that an emergency does exist before authorizing dependents to board the bus.
