Students

Admission

1. Purpose and Scope
 - A. Procedure for enrollment and admission of students entering the district's schools.
 - B. The student who applies for initial admission to the district's schools, by transfer from nonpublic schools or schools outside the district, will be placed in the high school grade level consistent with the eighth grade record. An entering student without transfer records for one or more semesters of high school shall be placed in a graduation class consistent with peers of like age, and an educational plan shall be developed to reflect individualized goals.
 - C. Under the direction of the Assistant Principal of Guidance, the student shall be programmed into classes applicable to the student's individual goals and objectives.
 - D. Exceptional children, who are in need of special programs, shall be evaluated by the school psychologist.
 - E. First priority for summer school enrollment shall be for students enrolled in the HBUHSD. Students from other district or private schools may enroll in summer session if there is room after all interested district students have been placed.
