Students

Questioning and Apprehension

Questioning

The following steps shall be taken to cooperate with outside law enforcement agencies:

1. The officer shall properly identify himself/herself to the principal or other designated administrator.
2. If an officer questions a student or takes any action with a student at school, the principal or designee shall be present. It is the responsibility of the officer to advise the student of his/her rights.
3. Following the questioning, the school will make a reasonable effort to notify parent and will document the efforts to make contact.

Apprehension

If the student is arrested, the principal or school official will release the student into the custody of the officer. The school official will take immediate steps to notify the parent/guardian or designated responsible relative by taking the following steps:

1. Telephone the parent/guardian or designated responsible relative, and document the efforts to make contact.
2. The Superintendent's designee (site principal) will be notified of the student's release to the officer and the reason therefore.
