Activities

The Governing Board recognizes that co-curricular activities are an integral part of the total curriculum of the school experience of students and as such, has educational benefit to students. Such activities should function to help build school spirit, school morale and provide opportunities for the student body organization.

It is the Board's intent to foster school activities that are deemed by the local principal as appropriate and beneficial to students within the limits provided by policy and administrative regulations and are not contrary to the Education Code. These activities are to be confined to the school campus and under school control except for those occasions where off-campus facilities are deemed more adaptable to the particular function by the principal.
