Students

Health Examination and Immunizations

The Governing Board recognizes the importance of periodic health examinations conducted according to state health regulations.

To determine the health status of students, facilitate the removal of barriers to learning, and determine whether special adaptations of the school program may be necessary, the Governing Board shall require that periodic examinations be conducted which include tests for vision and hearing.

The principal of each school shall notify parents and guardians of the rights of students and parents/guardians relating to health examinations and immunizations.

The Huntington Beach Union High School District shall follow state regulations in monitoring student compliance with immunization laws.
