Health Examinations and Immunizations

School Entrance Tuberculosis Test Requirement

All students new to HBUHSD in which this is the first school of enrollment from outside of the United States will be required to have a valid TB test prior to enrollment.

Tuberculosis testing is not required if the student has attended a school in California or any other U.S. state prior to entering HBUHSD, unless there is a history of a positive TB result or the school nurse determines there is a positive risk factor for TB (refer to California TB risk assessment questionnaire).

(cf. Health and Safety Code Section 121485)

Any student who does not show evidence of required tuberculosis test or assessment or who does not present a letter from a licensed health care provider* citing reasons for exemption based on medical contraindications shall be excluded from school until such time as the assessment is obtained or medical exemption has been filed with the school.

If there is probable cause to believe that a student has infectious tuberculosis, he/she will be excluded from school until the County Health Department is satisfied that he/she is not so afflicted (Health and Safety Code 3406).

CCR Title 5 section 202 - exclusion of pupils with contagious/infectious disease

*Licensed Health Care Provider as defined by HBUHSD is an MD, DO, NP, or PA.
