### GUIDELINES FOR CURRICULAR CLUBS AND NON-CURRICULAR GROUPS

#### CURRICULUM

- Related to curriculum\*
- Club
- School sponsored
- May use school public address announcement system and bulletin
- Meet during school day
- Meet after school
- School advisor required
- Participatory advisor
- With administrative approval, may involve non-school personnel in meeting
- ASB approved school charter required
- Access to ASB financial account

#### NON-CURRICULUM

- Not related to curriculum\*
- Group
- Not school sponsored
- May not use school public address announcement system and bulletin
- Meet at lunch
- Meet after school (4:00 p.m.) with Civic Center contract
- School supervisor required
- Non-participatory supervisor
- May not involve non-school personnel in meetings
- Facilities request form required
- No ASB financial account

- Club picture in yearbook
- May use instructional audio-visual equipment
- May participate in school sponsored fundraising programs
- May display posters based upon ASB and administrative approval
- Group picture in yearbook on a fee basis as non-curricular equal access group
- May not use instructional audio-visual equipment
- May fundraise but not participate in school sponsored fundraising programs
- May display posters based upon ASB and administrative approval in designated area

\* All curriculum related clubs must relate to the body of courses offered by the school and be approved by the District Instructional Council. A club directly relates to the school's curriculum, if the subject matter of the club is actually taught, or will soon be taught, in a regularly offered course; if the subject matter of the club concerns the body of courses as a whole; if participation in the club is required for a particular course; or if participation in the club results in academic credit.
