Instruction

Emergencies and Disaster Preparedness Plan

The school district students and staff must be prepared to respond immediately and responsibly to any combination of events which threaten to result in a disaster as well as to a disaster when it occurs.

The Superintendent or his designee shall develop and maintain a disaster plan which makes provisions for handling all foreseeable emergencies and disasters, and which shall also be adaptable for unforeseeable disasters. The plan shall be reviewed and updated, at least annually, and located at each school site and the district office.

The Superintendent is authorized to make district facilities available to public agencies, including the American Red Cross, for mass care and public shelters and cooperate with such agencies in furnishing services deemed necessary to meet community needs during emergencies.

The district plan may allow bus seating capacity limits to be exceeded when a disaster or hazard requires students to be moved immediately to ensure their safety.
