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## Instruction

### Evaluation of the Instructional Program

The Governing Board is committed to the use of a comprehensive system of evaluation of the instructional program that meets the general program information needs of the Board, the administration, and the school staffs. The Board recognizes that the intent of such program evaluation is the improvement of the instructional program and that program improvement results from a team effort among staff at all levels.

The administration shall submit an annual program assessment report to the Board stating general strengths and weaknesses in the instructional program of the district and the individual comprehensive high schools. Additional reports regarding specific aspects of the instructional program shall be made to the Board when deemed advisable by the Superintendent or upon request of the Board.
