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New Construction

Site Development

The Governing Board believes that site selection and development starts from the premise that the school is an integral and inseparable part of the total community.

Criteria shall be established and procedures maintained that insure the best possible sites are being acquired and developed at the least expenditure of funds.

The Superintendent shall insure that every school is master planned for ultimate development. This planning shall include the locations of all buildings, grounds, and service facilities. If all buildings in the master plan are not constructed in the first phase, a tentative second phase schedule shall be developed.
