New Construction

Determining Extent of New Construction

1. Purpose and Scope

To determine the size and number of proposed high schools.

2. Regulations

- A. It is the intent of the district to plan high schools with a permanent, single session capacity of (or about) a 3,000 student enrollment. Such schools may be developed in increments toward this goal, or may be planned and built as a complete facility to house all four grade levels. It is recognized that conditions in a given area may dictate that the capacity of a school may deviate to provide greater flexibility or more economical use, and, consequently, the school size may be adjusted to meet indicated needs. Such adjustment shall be reviewed by the Board.
- B. In addition to the general criteria outlined in A above, specific items to be considered are:
- (1) Enrollment information and forecasts.
 - (2) Educational specifications.
 - (3) Special and community use of facilities.
 - (4) Consideration of modification or expansion of existing facilities.
 - (5) Change in pupil-teacher (staffing) ratio.
