Bylaws of the Board

Filling Vacancies

A vacancy on the Governing Board may occur for any of the events specified in Government Code 1770. Removal by conviction of a grand jury or recall election shall also constitute a vacancy on the Board.

Within sixty (60) days of the date of the vacancy or the filing of the Board member's deferred resignation, the Board shall either:

1. Order an election for the next regular election date; or
2. Make a provisional appointment.

If the vacancy occurs within four (4) months of the end of the Board member's term, the Board shall not fill the vacancy.

Provisional Appointment

The Board shall make a provisional appointment, within the time limits and according to the procedures set by law.
