Bylaws of the Board

Orientation

The magnitude of school board membership calls for knowledge of and orientation to many areas of information and understandings. Under the guidance of experienced Board members and the Superintendent, orientation will be provided to new Board members through activities such as:

1. Workshop for new Board members conducted by state and area school boards associations;
2. Discussions and visits with the Superintendent and other members of the school staff;
3. Provision of printed and audio-visual materials on school board and administrative policies and procedures.

Orientation shall be considered as an ongoing process for all school Board members, and may include such activities as those indicated above and the addition of items such as:

1. Attendance at school Board and administrative conferences and conventions on a local, area, state and national basis;
2. Exchange of ideas through joint meetings with neighboring school boards;
3. District workshops.
